**CONTESTANTS CHECK-IN: BETWEEN 11:30 A.M. – 12:00 P.M.**

The following rules are to be adhered to by all cook-off cooks, and/or assistants:

1. Chili is defined as any kind of meat or combination of meats cooked with chili peppers, various other spices and other ingredients. All types of chili are accepted.
2. The entry fee will be \$20.00 per chili entered. Contestants may enter more than 1 batch of chili. This will be a Winner Takes All competition.
3. All ingredients must be pre-cooked and treated prior to the event-chili is to be brought ready to eat.
4. Contestants are responsible for supplying all of their own utensils and products related to their chili submission and maintenance of its proper temperature for serving. An electrical outlet will be available for each entry and a crockpot is recommended. Spoons and cups for use in serving chili to the general public will be provided. Condiments will be provided by HHCC.
5. Each contestant must cook a minimum of six (6) quarts (crockpot) of competition chili.
6. Each contestant will be assigned a "contestants number" by the scorekeeper and will be judged by the general public.
7. Judging will be based on scorecards, which are numbered. 100% of judging will be from scorecards from "people's choice."
8. Each contestant is responsible for policing and cleaning up the area at the end of the day and removing all items from the area. There will not be an area for cleaning of dishes. No items shall be allowed to remain after the close of the Cook-off.
